Colonoscopy

A procedure where a doctor examines the colon and rectum with a flexible tube that contains a camera to detect and remove polyps or other abnormalities.

Cologuard™ DNA Stool Test

A stool sample screening that analyzes DNA to detect genetic mutations and blood that might indicate colorectal cancer or precancerous polyps.

Fit™ Stool Test

A stool sample screening that detects hidden blood in the stool, which may be a sign of colorectal cancer or polyps.

Shield™ Blood Test

A blood-based screening that detects biomarkers associated with colorectal cancer by analyzing DNA fragments shed by tumors into the bloodstream.
